**STBU DELEGATES & ALTERNATE DELEGATES
TO AMPA 2008
(Annual Meeting of the OSSTF Provincial Assembly)
March 7 - 10, 2008**

Eligible members (day school, continuing education day school and night school) who are interested in being delegates should submit their name and membership number to the District 12 Office (phone: 393-8900; fax: 393-8912) by 4:30 p.m. on Thursday, December 6, 2007. Only if an insufficient number of names have been submitted will nominations be accepted at the STBU Council Meeting on Thursday, December 13.

The number of delegates and alternate delegates is determined by the Provincial Office. Provincial Councillors are automatically delegates.

Delegates *must* attend all planning meetings of the AMPA delegation which will take place on January 24, February 12 and February 20, 2008 beginning at 4:30 p.m. at the District Office, 1482 Bathurst Street.

Delegates *must also* be willing to work on District sub-committees studying motions, to assist in tasks related to organization of our AMPA delegation and to be present and to participate fully at the entire AMPA from Friday, March 7 to 4:00 pm on Monday, March 10, 2008.

Elections, if necessary, will take place at the December 13 STBU Council Meeting. Candidates for election will be introduced at Council. Candidates are asked not to bring printed literature. There will be only one ballot. All members of the STBU Council may vote for up to the total number of available delegate positions. The candidates receiving the highest number of votes will be elected as delegates and the next highest number of votes will determine alternate delegates. Candidates who are not elected may allow their names to go on a waiting list. If elected delegates are unable to fulfill their obligations, those positions will be filled by alternate delegates. Vacant alternate delegate positions may be filled from the waiting list.
